Native Azaleas

Generally deciduous shrubs of the *Rhododendron* genus that have clusters of trumpet shaped flowers. Flower color is often variable within species, so always read the tag. Species name is shown here underneath the common or hybrid name.

- Plant in morning Sun, with afternoon filtered light, unless otherwise noted.
- All azaleas need acidic (pH 6.0), well-drained soil.
- Native Azaleas are found in moist woodland areas, unless otherwise noted here.
- *Fr indicates fragrant flowers.

| 'Aromi Sunrise' (<i>R. austrinum hybrid</i>) | Bright Orange Spring | 6'H |
| Canescens *Fr (<i>R. canescens</i>) | Pink & White Early Spring | 5'-8'H, upright growth habit |
| Florida Flame *Fr (<i>R. austrinum</i>) | White & Pink <i>or</i> Yellow Spring | 8-10'H, upright growth habit Drought tolerant |
| 'Missionary Ridge' (<i>R. austrinum hybrid</i>) | Orange-Red Spring | 6'H |
| Piedmont (<i>R. minus</i>) Evergreen | Lavender-Pink Late Spring | 4-6'H x 4-6'W, dense rounded More sun tolerant |
| 'Southern Cerise' (<i>R. minus</i>) Evergreen | Bright Pink Late Spring | 2'H x 2'W Compact |
| Plumleaf (<i>R. prunifolium</i>) | Orange-Red Summer | 8-10'H x 6-8'W More sun tolerant |
| Radiant Red *Fr Aromi Hybrid | Deep Red w/ Yellow stamens Spring | 4-6'H x 4'W |
| 'Spring Fanfare' *Fr Aromi Hybrid | Deep Yellow Spring | 6-8'H x 4-6'W |
| Sweet Azalea *Fr (<i>R. viscosum</i>) | White Late Spring into Summer | 3-4'H |
