Native Azaleas

Generally deciduous shrubs of the *Rhododendron* genus that have clusters of trumpet shaped flowers. Flower color is often variable within species, so always read the tag. Species name is shown here underneath the common or hybrid name.

-Plant in morning Sun, with afternoon filtered light, unless otherwise noted.

-All azaleas need acidic (pH 6.0), well-drained soil.

-Native Azaleas are found in moist woodland areas, unless otherwise noted here.

-*Fr indicates fragrant flowers.
